GUIDELINES FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT



Abstinence is a penitential practice that consists of refraining from the consumption of meat. It is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

In addition to abstinence, **fasting** is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 (inclusive). On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting.

Note: If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are more suitable to their condition.
